SCIENCE/SOCIAL STUDIES

This week in Social Studies we will begin Chapter 5: *What Makes Our Community Diverse?* In this chapter we will discuss the different foods, languages, holidays, and traditions that come from different cultures.

LITERACY THIS WEEK READER'S WORKSHOP

We will also review character trait analysis, identifying the moral/lesson, and determining the meaning of figurative language.

WRITER'S WORKSHOP

This week in Writer's Workshop we will continue with the Selecting and Collecting stages of our Schoolwide Opinion Writing Unit: Biography. In our Selecting lesson, students will select subjects that they feel their readers should learn about, and they will consider how their research will support their opinions and show their readers why the subject is important. In Collecting Lesson 1, students will develop a strategy for collecting facts in the form of a list. Students will also finish writing their Earth Day Haikus.



MATH LESSONS THIS WEEK GUIDED MATH STATIONS EUREKA MODULE 6: LESSONS 9

On Monday, we will rotate through guided math stations in order to review the key concepts and skills taught in Module 6, as well as begin filling out the Module 6 study guide.
