This week in Social Studies we will finish Chapter 6: *How Do People Improve Their Communities?* In this chapter, we will read about various influential people in America's history and what they have done to improve their communities. # LITERACY THIS WEEK

#### READER'S WORKSHOP

This week in Reader's Workshop, we will continue our Poetry Unit. In Lesson 4, students will figure out a poet's inspiration in order to help them understand the big idea hidden inside a poem using *The Underwear Salesman* by J. Patrick Lewis. In Lesson 5, students will use Reading, *Rhyming, and 'Rithmetic* by Dave Cawley and *Every Second Something Happens* by Christine San Jose and Bill Johnson to question how words in a poem make them feel and understand that those feelings help them better understand the poems they read.

#### WRITER'S WORKSHOP

This week in Writer's Workshop, we will continue with the Drafting stage of our Schoolwide Opinion Writing Unit: Biography. In Drafting Lesson 1, students will create leads for their biographies that hold their readers' attention and state their opinion about their subjects. In Drafting Lesson 2, students will write the body paragraphs of their biographies using the chronological text structure.





## MATH LESSONS THIS WEEK

#### MODULE 7: LESSONS 12-16

This week we will continue Module 7: Geometry and Measurement Word Problems. In Lessons 12-16 we will measure side lengths in whole number units to determine the perimeter of polygons, explore perimeter as an attribute of plane figures in order to solve problems, determine the perimeter of regular polygons and rectangles when whole number measurements are missing, solve word problems to determine perimeter with given side lengths, and use string to measure the perimeter of various circles to the nearest quarter inch.
