SCIENCE/SOCIAL STUDIES

This week we will begin Chapter 3: Types of Animals. In this chapter students will investigate what animals need to live and the difference between vertebrates and invertebrates.

We will practice the "I Heard You Read" Strategy as students read the chapter together and discuss the key concepts presented in the chapter.

LITERACY THIS WEEK

READER'S WORKSHOP

This week we will revisit our mentor texts, *Henry and the Buccaneer Bunnies, Swish, Surprising Sharks,* and *Someday*. Students will be participating in a discussion where they will be identifying the moral of a story. We will also use the poem, *The Twister* as we further develop our strategy of making connections to our reading. Lastly, we will discuss the importance of staying focused while reading and how it will help us grow as readers. Students will practice the various skills and strategies during their independent reading time.

Writer's Workshop

This week students will finalize their narrative writing topic. We will confirm if our idea is "The One" and gather our resources that will assist in our writing. Finally, we will begin drafting our narratives.

This week we will also introduce our Fall writing activity, Picasso Frankenstein. Students will create their own Frankenstein using Pablo Picasso's style of art as inspiration. They will then create a story to go along with their picture.





MATH LESSONS THIS WEEK

EUREKA MODULE 1: REVIEW AND END-OF-MODULE ASSESSMENT

EUREKA MODULE 2: LESSONS 1-3

This week we will review our study guide, take our End-of-Module assessment, and begin Module 2.

Students will explore time as a continuous measurement using a stopwatch; relate skip counting by fives on the clock and telling time to a continuous measurement model, the number line. Finally, students will count by fives and ones on the number line as a strategy to tell time to the nearest minute on the clock.
